## **ENTRY FORMS**

Exhibitors must complete "STATEMENT BY EXHIBITOR" section on the front page of the entry form advising their taxation status.

## **PRIZE MONEY AND GST**

Prize Money stated in the Schedule excludes GST. GST will be added to the Prize Money for Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.

The Association will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes. Prize money will be paid by EFT to the winners after the competition, and will not be presented on the day.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

The time limit (including preamble) for all performers is six (6) minutes. Three points will be deducted by each judge to any performer exceeding the six minutes.

Due to time restrictions the number of competitors in the Open Section will be limited to 25. The RNA will attempt to accommodate all student entries.

**Although the Bobby Miller Memorial Trophy will be judged on the most humorous poem, presented in the Open Classes, please be aware humorous or serious may be performed.**

Material that the judges deem to be offensive will not be scored.

A random draw for the order of performances will be held after 22 June 2011. Organisers reserve the right to adjust the draw to avoid "same poems" being performed consecutively.

## **COMPETITION CLASSES**

### **OPEN**

Open to performers who have previously won a Novice Competition or performers who prefer to enter an Open Class Competition. This section is NOT open to school students.

#### **Class 1 Open - Established Poem**

The poem selected can be from any published author other than the person performing.

The prize money will be shared equally between the best three performers in this class.

First prize \$50, Product, Certificate; Second \$50, Certificate; Third \$50, Certificate

The poem selected must have been written by the performer.

The prize money will be shared equally between the best three performers in this class.
