# EDUCATION ON SHOW

Education on Show is a section of the Royal Queensland Show (Ekka) devoted to acknowledging the work completed by students throughout Queensland.

The competition covers a wide range of contemporary curriculum related skills and activities addressing Key Learning Areas (KLA). It has been designed to encourage students to strive to do their best as the school's selected best works will be judged and on display at Ekka. It has also been designed to encourage teachers to use the competition as a resource tool for assessment.

## 2011 THEME

### RENEWAL

As the RNA Showgrounds undergo an extensive redevelopment process over the next fifteen years, Ekka will be re-energised for future generations.

The topic of Renewal encompasses many areas and students will have an opportunity to explore different topic areas:

- Growth - demonstrating and experiencing growth patterns, for example life cycles.
- Everything Old is New Again - students can focus on rejuvenating old concepts.
- Renewable Energy - still a hot topic which will allow students to demonstrate their knowledge on this sustainable source of energy.
- Back to the Future - students can address the rich traditions of the iconic Ekka or showcase their creativity with the creation of a piece of wearable jewellery, a mural, photography piece or painting.

### SCOPE

All entries must be created in the 2011 school calendar year.

Schools are encouraged to conduct their own competitions and to send their best works to Ekka to be judged.

Students are to be encouraged to provide work that demonstrates a balance between ICT skills and hand generated presentations.

### WHO CAN ENTER

Any school student may enter. Special Needs and Distance Education schools are encouraged to enter.

Class eligibility is determined by student's year level. All entries must be made via the school.

Only one entry per student per competition class can be accepted. No shared entry except for Class 14 (group mural).

### SIZES

Painting: Maximum size A3 (297mm x 420mm)

Report/Picture: Maximum size A4 (210mm x 297mm), single sided unless stated

Any 3 dimensional piece: Maximum size 300mm x 300mm x 500mm

## PREP TO YEAR 2

### GROWTH

#### **Class 1 Picture Story (KLA - English/Science)**

Create a picture story (with captions) of something you have grown or observed growing.

Maximum 4 frames.  
Maximum size: A3.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

#### **Class 2 Mobile (KLA - Science/ICT)**

Design a mobile depicting the "Life Cycle of a Living Thing."

Maximum size: no bigger than 300mm x 300mm.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

#### **Class 3 Painting (KLA - Visual Arts) "Digging in My Vegie Patch"**

Maximum size: A3.

## YEAR 3 TO YEAR 5

### EVERYTHING OLD IS NEW AGAIN

#### **Class 4 Old Fashioned Recipe (KLA - English)**

Present a traditional recipe (with illustrations) with a new flavour twist.

Maximum size: A4.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

#### **Class 5 Everything Old is New Again (KLA - Arts/ICT)**

Create a new card from old material. For example a birthday or greetings card. (No inside text is needed).

Maximum size: A5.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

**Class 6 PowerPoint Presentation (KLA - ICT)  
Toys - Past and Present**

A presentation on toys from the past which don't require consumable energy and are still used today.

Maximum length: 3 minutes

Presentation to be provided on a USB stick or a disc. No print versions will be accepted.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

**Class 7 Painting (KLA - Visual Arts)**  
Using the topic "Something old made new again..." create a painting.

Maximum size: A3.

### RENEWABLE ENERGY

**Class 8 Persuasive Writing (KLA – English/SOSE)**  
Influence people to use public transport.

Maximum length: A4.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

**Class 9 Cartoon (KLA - Science/SOSE/English/Visual Arts)**  
Create your own Super Hero character who encourages the use of renewable energy sources.

Maximum 10 cells 5 on 5.  
100mm x 100mm each cell.  
Present landscape format.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

**Class 10 Model (KLA - Technology/Arts/Science)**  
Design and build an Ekka Ride using renewable energy e.g.: a solar powered ferris wheel.

Maximum size: 300mm x 300mm x 500mm.

**Class 11 Painting (KLA-Visual Arts)**  
Using the topic "Something old made new again..." create a painting.

Maximum size: A3.

**Class 12 Web Design (KLA – ICT/ENGLISH)**  
Design a web page informing people of renewable energy options.

Format: HTML  
Submit on a USB stick or disc. No printed versions will be accepted.

**Class 13 Jewellery Design (KLA - Arts)**  
Something Old is New Again

Design and make a wearable piece of jewellery made from reused material.

Piece can be mounted on a card or displayed in a shallow box.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

**Class 14 Mural - Group Entry (KLA - Visual Arts)**  
"Ekka of the Future"

Create a mural using any media addressing the above topic.

Maximum size: 1m wide x 40cm deep.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

**Class 15 Photography (KLA - Visual Arts)**  
New Horizon - CityScape

Digital or standard images, black and white or colour work must be printed on quality paper.

Maximum size of photo: A4.  
To be presented unframed but suitably mounted on card to give a 2-5cm border.

First prize \$30, Certificate; Second \$20, Certificate; Third \$10, Certificate

**Class 16 PowerPoint Presentation (KLA – ICT)**  
Heritage and Traditions of Ekka

Maximum length: 3 minutes  
Presentation to be provided on a USB stick or a disc. No print versions will be accepted.

**Schools are eligible for one major prize only.**

To enter, School Principals or Coordinators are required to certify on the School Entry Form the total number of students currently enrolled in the school.

Points will be awarded on the following basis:

| School Enrolment   | 1st Prize | 2nd Prize | 3rd Prize |
|--------------------|-----------|-----------|-----------|
| Up to 100 students | 6         | 5         | 4         |
| 101 - 300 students | 5         | 4         | 3         |
| 301 - 600 students | 4         | 3         | 2         |
| Over 600 students  | 3         | 2         | 1         |

(includes total enrolments Prep to Year 12)

Prize monies will be deposited into the school's nominated bank account by the end of October. Disbursement of monies to students is the responsibility of the school.

Prize money excludes GST. GST will be added for Schools who are registered for GST. The RNA will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" for entrants who are registered for GST.
