# QUILTS ACROSS QUEENSLAND

## ENTRY CHECKLIST

- You have checked your non-professional or professional status
- You have read every Condition of Entry
- You have checked that every section has been filled in on your Entry form
- You have provided a description of your quilt to be included in the Quilts Across Queensland Catalogue. This includes acknowledgement of Pattern/Workshop/Magazine/Book the entered quilt has drawn inspiration from. Attach a separate page to your entry form with these details.
- For class 7 and 8, you have included the name of the commercial quilter
- You have attached a photo of your Quilt(s) to the entry form
- You have completed the payment fields on the entry form
- You have ensured your entry form is received by Friday 8 July 2011 at 4.30pm
- You have attached a quilt label to each quilt
- You have attached a 3" hanging sleeve
- You have an ample sized labeled cloth/box/tough bag for each quilt
- You have sufficiently completed all postal requirements for the safe return of your Quilt(s)

# QUILTS ACROSS QUEENSLAND

Subject to the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland Act 1971 and to the constitution, rules and by-laws of the Association the following regulations shall apply to Quilts Across Queensland.

## REGULATIONS

1. The quilts will be professionally hung, judged and displayed during the Royal Queensland Show, 11 - 20 August 2011.
2. Commercial quilting outlets will be invited to demonstrate and sell their wares in an adjacent area.
3. Exhibitors must state on the 'entry form' the classes in which they are competing.
4. Quilts must not have been shown at previous Royal Queensland Shows and must have been completed within 3 years prior to the first day of the 2011 Royal Queensland Show.
5. There is no restriction on the number of entries.
6. For classes 3 and 6 - (Small Quilt - any technique - this can include wall hangings, pictorial quilts, art quilts and cot quilts in any technique). Maximum 500 cm outer perimeter.
7. For purposes of identification, **all quilts must carry a label on the back** stating the Exhibitor's name and address, title of quilt and date of completion.
8. **Ensure a 3 inch hanging sleeve is attached.**
9. Include a non-returnable photograph of quilt exhibit. Exhibitor's name and address must appear on back of photograph.
10. Indicate size in centimeters giving horizontal (top) measurement first. State whether quilt is to be hung horizontally or vertically.
11. The Association reserves the right to exhibit or reject any or all of the entries. Hanging of quilts for display is at the discretion of the Judges and Honorary Council Stewards.
12. A quilt made by 2 or more people is only eligible for the collaborative quilt class.
13. Quilts must be the maker's own work, including piecing, quilting and binding if entered under one name.
14. **Entries in class 11 must be submitted under the name of the nominating show society.**

Quilts entered must be 'Best of Show' or equivalent and only one quilt per Show Society can be entered in this class. Prizes for this class will be awarded to the quilt maker. Shows held after the RNA closing date for nominations, may submit an entry form prior to their show judging in the name of the Show Society. Details of the entry may be forwarded with the quilt.

Quilts judged in Shows after 22 July 2011 may be entered in the following year.

15. Full Details must be supplied and attribution given if your quilt is made in a class or workshop, or from a publication. **Please also include these details in your quilt description for the catalogue. No Kit Quilts allowed. Please state the origin of where your pattern has come from.**
16. It is the responsibility of the quilt maker to obtain permission and pay any fee regarding the use of copyright material.
17. In the Commercially Machine Quilted Quilt classes, the prize is only awarded to the quilt maker exhibitor but the commercial quilter will receive acknowledgment. Include name of commercial quilter in your description of quilt.
18. **All posted quilts to reach the RNA showgrounds by Friday 22 July 2011.** Quilts can be hand delivered to the upper level of the Dairy Hall on Friday 22 and Saturday 23 July 2011 between 10.00am and 3.00pm.
19. When forwarding or delivering exhibits, exhibitors must indicate the manner in which these exhibits are to be returned at the conclusion of the show.  
  
Ensure quilts are delivered in a cloth bag (not plastic) marked with exhibitor's name and full return address details on bag.  
  
Exhibits forwarded by rail or post are to be securely packed, addressed to the Entries Section, RNA, Locked Bag 1010, ALBION QLD 4010 and despatched (with return postpak/box and all charges prepaid) in sufficient time to reach showgrounds before the time and date prescribed.
20. **Quilts to be collected on Sunday 21 and Monday 22 August 2011 between 10.00am and 12 noon.**
21. **Return freight must be paid on all exhibits other than those to be collected.**
22. Advise if quilt is 'for sale' including RNA 10% commission and 10% GST.
23. Total prizes - approximately \$7,000 with \$500 awarded to Best of Show. Prizes winners will receive 2 complementary passes to 2011 Royal Queensland Show.
24. The Exhibitor irrevocably consents to the RNA publishing or reproducing in any manner whatsoever any particulars or information in relation to their exhibits; the publication or reproduction may be in a printed form or visual image through electronic means and/or the internet.
25. No Framed Quilts Allowed.
26. The Judges' decision shall be final and no correspondence shall be entered into.

## DEFINITION OF "PROFESSIONAL"

A professional quilter is defined as someone who teaches or publishes in the field of quilting; sells, designs or participates in making quilts for financial gain **or has won Best of Show or 2 blue ribbons in any major judged competition**, excluding Viewers' Choice. Having exhibited as a professional, amateur status cannot be resumed. A major judged competition is defined as any of a state or territory guild judged exhibition or competition, a national, or international competition or exhibition or Royal Show. Financial gain is defined as any amount above the cost of creating the quilt i.e. Cost of creating the articles, design, teaching aids, including samples, notes and travel expenses. Any exhibitor entering 'Non Professional' and who is found to be of 'Professional' status will forfeit their award and prize even after the event.

## ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

The attention of intending exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland Act 1971, and to the Constitution, Rules and by-laws of the Association. Copies of the Constitution, Rules and by-laws may be obtained upon application to the Entries Department.

## NOTICE TO INTENDING EXHIBITORS

Entries will only be received on the "Application to Enter" form enclosed with this schedule. Entries submitted other than on the correct form will be returned to the exhibitor and, unless all requirements are complied with and the forms returned to the office by 4.30pm on the "entry form" closing date as shown in the schedule, they will not be considered.

## RELEASES AND INDEMNITIES

The RNA, RNA Staff Members and Officials of the RNA shall not be liable to any Person for any loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence, neglect or breach of duty howsoever arising.

A quilt is defined as three layers of fabric held together at regular intervals by stitching or some other means.

### **Class 1 Non Professional - Pieced Quilt**

Predominately pieced (hand or machine pieced and quilted) also includes crazy quilts.  
First prize \$350, Rosette, Voucher; Second \$150, Rosette; Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended  
\$300 Voucher sponsored by Sewco Sewing & Patchwork Centre

### **Class 2 Lend Lease Non Professional - Applique or Other Techniques**

First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette; Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended  
\$580 sponsored by Lend Lease

### **Class 3 Lend Lease Non Professional - Small Quilt Any Technique**

Maximum 500cm outer perimeter  
First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette; Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended  
\$580 sponsored by Lend Lease

### **Class 4 Professional - Pieced Quilt**

Predominately pieced (hand or machine pieced and quilted) also includes crazy quilts.  
First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette; Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended

### **Class 5 Professional - Applique or Other Techniques**

First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette; Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended

### **Class 6 Professional - Small Quilt - Any Technique**

Maximum 500cm outer perimeter  
First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette; Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended

### **Class 7 Open - Collaborative - Commercially Quilted - Any technique**

Quilt top made by one person and commercially quilted  
First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette; Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended

- Class 8 Open - Collaborative Quilt Made by More Than Two People**  
Includes round robin, friendship and raffle quilts.  
Quilts may be commercially quilted.  
First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette;  
Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended
- Class 9 Open - Art Quilt - Any Technique**  
First prize \$350, Rosette; Second \$150, Rosette;  
Third \$80, Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended
- Class 10 Junior Section Under 18 years - Any Technique**  
First prize Product, Rosette; Second Product, Rosette; Third Rosette; Fourth Highly Commended; Fifth Commended  
Sewing Machine sponsored by Greg & Jan Allen's Pleasuresew
