Subject to the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland Act 1971, and to the Constitution, Rules and By-Laws of the Association The following Special Regulations shall apply to the Feline Section.

### **REGULATIONS**

1. Judging will commence at 9.00am.
2. All felines are to be benched by 8:15am each day and remain on exhibit to 5:00pm.
3. Only the owner or their representative may remove the exhibit at the end of the day.
4. If the exhibitor arrives after the stipulated benching time, and judging has commenced, then the exhibitor will forfeit being judged in that Ring and must wait until the judge has completed judging before benching their exhibit.
5. Any cat entered for competition and present at the Show may not be withdrawn from competition without the consent of the Councillor in Charge.
6. Prize Cards and Ribbons won at the 2011 Royal Queensland Show may be displayed once judging is completed. Any Ribbons won outside of this Show can not be displayed.
7. Should any question arise for which no specific guidance is provided, the matter shall be referred to the Councillor in charge whose decision on the matter shall be final.
8. It is an offence for any person to remove or alter the location of any exhibit from the cages allocated. Failure to observe this requirement may result in withdrawal of the exhibits. You are required to seek prior approval from the Councillor in Charge before any changes are made.
9. Any exhibit, if found to be entered in the wrong class, will be transferred to the correct class.
10. No kitten under the age of ten (10) weeks is permitted to be shown.
11. **All exhibits (except Companion Felines) must be registered and registration numbers listed on the Entry Form.**
12. **A photocopy of each exhibits registration certificate must accompany the entry form.**
13. Registration pending will not be accepted.
14. No Exhibit will be reclassified for colour or pattern at the Show.
15. Any exhibit found to have colouring matter or powder will be disqualified. No grooming is to be done on Judging Tables.
16. All exhibits must have claws clipped (front and back).
17. Any exhibit showing fractious or aggressive behaviour to being handled in any ring will be disqualified from all rings.
18. Exhibitors with their exhibits must enter and exit the showgrounds via St Paul's Terrace (on the corner of Alexandria Street & St Paul's Terrace).
19. All Exhibits will only be allowed onto the Showgrounds if in a carriage container.
20. There is no parking available on grounds for exhibitors. Parking is available in the Fortitude Valley State School Car Park for a fee.
21. **All Exhibitors must supply their own coloured cage curtains and provide own cage or hire cage available.**

22. Any complaint must be in writing and must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 and must be lodged within seven (7) days of the Show.
23. Should any question arise for which no specific guidance is provided, the matter shall be referred to the Councillor in Charge whose decision on the matter shall be final.
24. All kittens must be vaccinated a minimum of at least two (2) weeks prior to the commencement of the Royal Queensland Show.
25. Cage hire available at a cost of \$10.00.
26. Individual kitten entries from kitten litter entries will attract a \$10.00 additional entry fee.
27. **PASS ALLOCATION**

Entry passes will be allocated to Exhibitors on the following basis:

- 1 or 2 entries – 1 pass
- 3 to 5 entries – 2 passes
- 6 or more entries – 3 passes

Winning exhibits will be required to return for Group Specials judging on Wednesday 17 August 2011 and will need to collect entry passes from the Steward.

**Entries for 2011 must be made on the "Application to Enter" form enclosed with this schedule.**

Entry submissions other than on the correct form will be returned to the Exhibitor and, unless all requirements are complied with and the forms returned to the office by 4.30pm on the closing date, as shown in the Schedule, they will not be accepted.

Entry Fees must accompany the Entry Form.

### **ENTRY FORMS**

- Exhibitors **must complete** the "STATEMENT BY EXHIBITOR" section on the front page of the entry form advising their taxation status.

### **PRIZE MONEY**

- Prize Money stated in the Schedule **excludes GST.**
- GST will be added to the Prize Money for Exhibitors who are **registered for GST purposes.**

The Association will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.

### **WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT 1995**

1. The RNA Showgrounds are a designated Workplace within the meaning of the Act and Exhibitors/Competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or sub-contractors, comply with all requirements of the Act and the RNA holds each Exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the Exhibitor/Competitor of any area of the RNA Showgrounds.
2. Each Exhibitor/Competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other Exhibitors, RNA staff, show visitors and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

3. Risks identified by Exhibitors/Competitors will be eliminated or controlled by the Exhibitor/Competitor and particular attention will be paid to ensuring public safety and safety of other Exhibitors/Competitors.
4. Exhibits will only be handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the Exhibitor/Competitor.
5. A **"No Smoking Policy"** will be strictly adhered to and policed by Exhibitors/ Competitors. Exhibitors/Competitors are advised that the use of Primus stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly **prohibited** in the pavilions.
6. Any Exhibitors/Competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the RNA Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is **prohibited** and all power boards must be tested and tagged.
